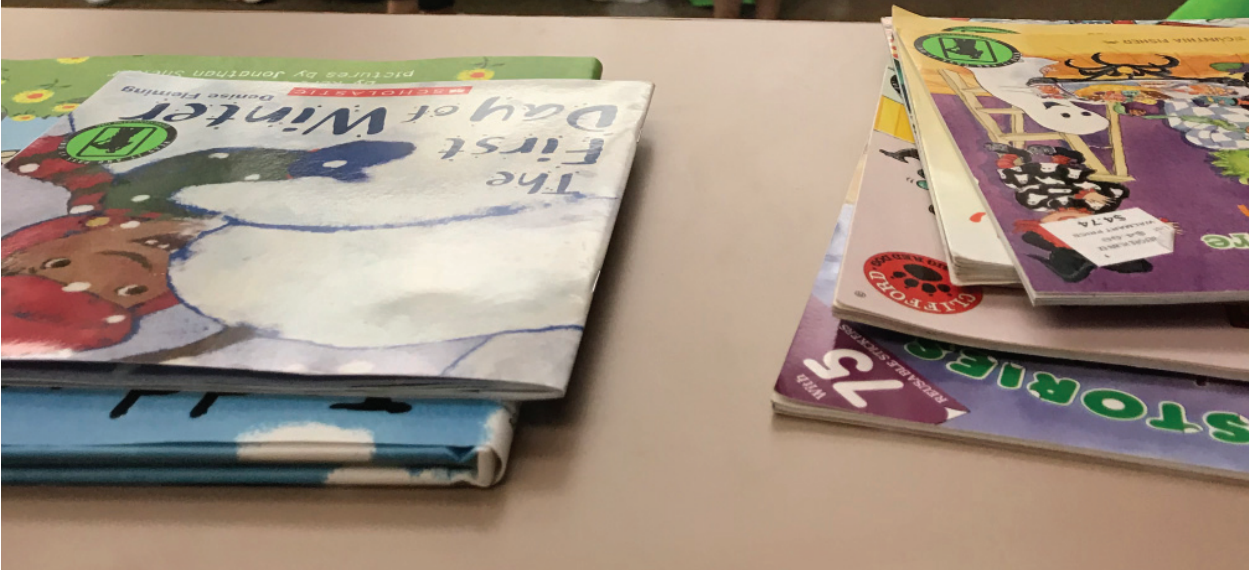
2018 Giving-At-A-Glance

- The Adams Street 2-1 Employee Matching Gift Program gave to more than 62 global organizations in 2018.
- In recognition of employees who serve on boards or invest significant volunteer time with an organization, the firm made several additional grants to non-profits.
- Gifts made through employee-driven initiatives accounted for more than 43% of Adam Street's 2018 charitable giving.

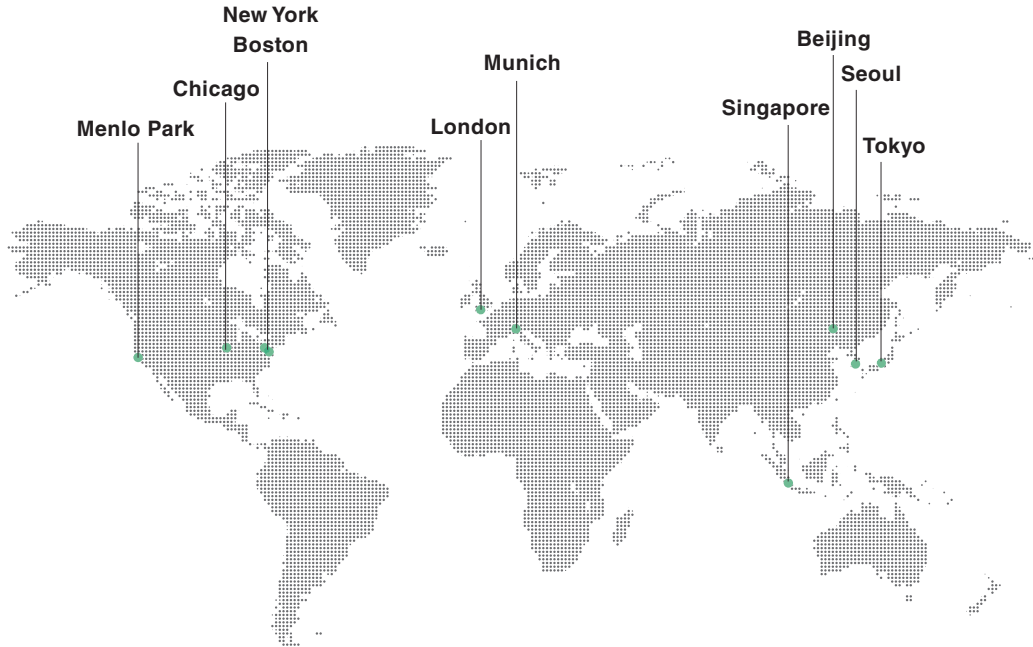
